**Sub: Consent letter of temporary approval of affiliation to School of Law and Juridical Science, Apex Professional University, East Siang, Arunachal Pradesh for imparting three year LLB and five year BA LLB law courses with an intake of two section in each course in each course.**

Sir,

Standing Committee at its meeting held on **23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2016** considered the above mentioned subject. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations: -

The Standing Committee considered the inspection report of School of Law and Juridical Science, Apex Professional University, East Siang, Arunachal Pradesh and further, Committee is of the view that as per Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 University be granted recognition for the purpose of conferring the degree of law for imparting three year and five year law courses and also granted fresh approval of affiliation to **School of Law and Juridical Science, Apex Professional University, East Siang, Arunachal Pradesh** for running **three year LL.B** course and **five year BA LL.B** course with an intake of **two sections** of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of one year i.e. for the academic years 2016-2017 subject to the following conditions :-

1. The college management is directed to establish the Legal Aid Centre as per Clause-11, Schedule-III of Rule-11 of the Part-IV of the Legal Education Rules - 2008.
2. College should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library by investing minimum Rs. 50,000/- per year per stream.
4. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.
5. To buy text books @ 10 in each subject and journals in terms of clause 15 in schedule III of the Legal Education Rules, 2008 as initial investment.
6. To comply and maintain the requirements of 'Core-Faculty' as per the provisions of Rule 17 of Schedule-III of the Legal Education Rules-2008.
7. The class routine in each section shall be as per the provisions of Rule 17 of Schedule-III of the Legal Education Rules-2008.



However, it is found that the qualifications of faculty members are not mentioned properly. The university to send the same within four weeks separately both for three year and five year courses showing name, qualification of faculty members, their experience, which subject they are teaching, salary, etc.

The Committee also finds that there is no toilet for boys and girls and not for the staff. This should be constructed within three months with intimation to the Bar Council of India through affidavit. Committee also finds that there is no staff room which should also be constructed with the same period.


Further, there is no legal aid cell which should be constructed within three months to be intimated to the Bar Council of India with the same period and to be made functional under Clause 11 and 18 of Schedule III of Legal Education Rules 2008.

This consent letter of approval is provided for only one year. The final letter will follow having other conditions.


The above recommendation is subject to approval by the Legal Education Committee and Bar Council of India.
